Symbols of Easter

Can you identify each of the symbols used during Easter? Many have pagan origins that Christians have adapted.

Spring Flowers & Baby Animals - symbolizes new life.

Easter Bunny - Is an ancient symbol of fertility, new life and the coming of spring. Early Christians may have adopted the rabbit as a symbol of Christ emerging from his tomb.

The Egg - A pagan symbol of fertility and rebirth, the egg has been a natural symbol of new life. In Christianity, it also came to represent Christ's empty tomb. In the 13th century, Christians colored eggs deep red to symbolize the blood of Christ and the joy of Resurrection. The Easter Egg Roll (like on the White House lawn) may have symbolized rolling away the stone from Christ's tomb.

New Clothes at Easter - The custom probably began with early Christians wearing new white robes for baptism during Easter Vigil services.

Lamb - Jesus is often referred to in the Bible as the "Lamb of God." The lamb was a sacrifice made during the Jewish Passover, and it in turn became a symbol of Jesus' sacrifice.

Butterfly - Its whole life cycle can symbolize the life of Jesus. The caterpillar can stand for His life on Earth. The cocoon stage can represent the burial of Jesus. The butterfly signifies His raising from the dead in a glorified body.

The Cross - The cross is perhaps the most powerful and recognizable symbol of Christianity. The cross symbolizes Christ's victory over sin and death.

Embrace and celebrate some of these traditions, but make sure you pass on to your children and grandchildren, your nieces and nephews the Christian message behind it all.
